Boost Oregon continued to innovate and enhance the immunization space in Oregon and beyond in 2023. As the only parent-led, vaccine education organization in the country, we offered what overworked and underfunded medical and public health entities could not: individualized, personalized responses to vaccine hesitancy.

We educated the public directly through culturallyresponsive programs, events, and materials, including our animated video series that won a prestigious national award. We trained thousands of medical providers and social services professionals on how to communicate effectively about vaccines and improve their relationships with patients and clients. We championed peer advocates and amplified diverse voices to improve the health outcomes

In 2023, we expanded our proven methodologies and reached new audiences. We created and led a robust motivational interviewing curriculum that trains people to use collaborative conversational skills to support behavior change. We launched a second podcast, "Neighborhood Doctor," that provides medical information and parenting advice. We expanded our peer advocacy

program to college campuses, and we counseled youth in custody at six different facilities across the state.

Boost Oregon's programs are unique, and they work. We increase people's knowledge about vaccines, their confidence about accepting or promoting immunizations, and their intentions to vaccinate themselves and their families. Our efforts have been recognized and praised by national and state


